

Summer Reading Tasks for Freshmen, Sophomores, and Juniors <u>not</u> in AP or IB. Please select a book from the appropriate list provided or select a book of your choice. If you select a book on your own you MUST email Mrs. Abbott by July 1st with the name and author of the book you would like to read. Your book MUST be approved by Mrs. Abbott or you will not get credit for summer reading. Direct questions to Mrs. Abbott labbott@notredamehs.com

In addition to reading a book, you must complete reading tasks and record them in a google document. You may choose from the list below which tasks to complete in order to reach 100 points. Links to any videos created should be in the document or if that is not possible please include in your journal information about the video and instructions for the teacher to be able to access the video.

How do you earn points?

1. Reading Without Walls - Read one book that fits one of the criteria below and write two
paragraphs explaining how the book fits the criteria with regard to you.50 pts.

- Read a book about a character that does not look like you or live like you
- Read a book about a topic that you don't know much about
- Read a book in a format that you don't normally read (a graphic novel, short story collection, poetry collection, a book of letters if you need suggestions just ask)
- You must write <u>two paragraphs</u> in your journal about your book and how it fits this criteria

2. Get a library card - Take a photo of the card w/your name and upload to digital Journal 10pts.

3. Create a new title for your book and explain why/how it relates	10 pts.
4. Create a short video depicting a scene from the book	20 pts.

5. Discuss your book with another student for 5 minutes - link recording to journal	10pts.
6. Listen to a podcast or read an article about the author of your book - record three things you learned in your journal.	10 pts.
7. Make a commercial for your book - email recording to teacher/record this task In your journal	20 pts.
8. Create a movie poster for your book in your journal, must include information a movie poster would have on it - not just a picture	10pts.
9. Read a book to a little kid - email teacher recording or link to digital journal	10pts.
10. Write a paragraph about a meal that you would prepare for a book club discussi about this book. You must explain your selections	on 10pts.
11. What happens next? Write a paragraph about what happens to the characters After the book is over?	10pts.
12. Write a paragraph about which actors you would cast in a movie adaptation of your book	10pts.
13. If your book had a theme song what would it be? Write a paragraph explaining.	10pts.
14. Write a poem about the main character in your book	10pts.
15. If you could be one character in your book which one would you be and why? Write one paragraph explaining your choice	10pts.
