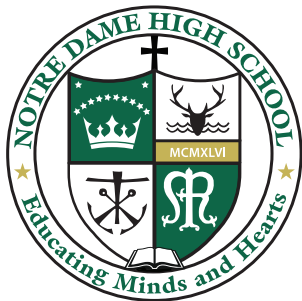

TRANSFER STUDENT OVERVIEW

Early Action Application Deadline is November 15, 2026

STEP 1. CREATE YOUR ONLINE ADMISSIONS PORTAL

- The first step for all prospective transfer students is to create an online admissions account so our team can personalize your ND experience. Creating a profile is simple, does not require a payment or commitment, and is your first step to learning more about our amazing community.
- Scan the QR code to the right and create your online account.

STEP 2. BEGIN YOUR ADMISSION APPLICATION

- When you are ready to start your admission application, access the application through your online admissions portal.

STEP 3. SUBMIT YOUR RECOMMENDATIONS TO ND

- We require two recommendations - one recommendation should be from your Guidance Counselor or Principal and the other recommendation should be from your current grade Math or English Teacher.
- Request your recommendations in your admissions portal.

STEP 4. REQUEST YOUR REPORT CARDS, TRANSCRIPTS, AND STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES

- Please send transcripts/report cards from the past two years, and the current year grades as soon as they are available. We will review applications with the first quarter or first trimester grades of the current year.
- Please request any Connecticut Mastery Tests, PSAT or any other standardized testing to be sent to ND.
- Records can be requested through your online admissions portal or by submitting a records release form to your current high school records office to authorize the release of your transcripts and standardized test scores.

STEP 5. SCHEDULE YOUR FAMILY ADMISSIONS INTERVIEW

- The final step to complete the transfer admission process is a family admission interview. The interview is an opportunity for us to answer questions you might have, review your application, discuss course placement, and finalize your admission decision. Standardized test results along with the other components of your application will provide a full picture of your academic abilities and potential. Please remember that your standardized test scores are only one part of your total application.

☐ STEP 1. CREATE YOUR ONLINE ADMISSIONS PORTAL

☐ STEP 2. SUBMIT YOUR ADMISSION APPLICATION

- ☐ Submit your application by logging into your online Admission Portal and selecting "Continue Application Process." Then, select "Complete Form" next to the Student Admissions Application section.

☐ STEP 3. SUBMIT YOUR RECOMMENDATIONS TO ND

- ☐ Principal or Guidance Counselor Recommendation
- ☐ Math or English Teacher Recommendation

☐ STEP 4. REQUEST YOUR REPORT CARDS, TRANSCRIPTS, AND STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES

- ☐ High School/Middle School Transcripts with at least two years of academic work and current year grades when available
- ☐ Connecticut Mastery Tests, Smarter Balanced Assessment results (SBAC), PSAT or IOWA Assessments
- ☐ Any other relevant standardized tests (such as your PSATs)
