# TRANSFER STUDENT OVERVIEW



## STEP I. Create your Online Admissions Portal

- The first step for all prospective students is to create an online admissions account so
  our team can personalize your ND experience. Creating a profile is simple, does not
  require a payment or commitment, and is your first step to learning more about our
  amazing community.
- Scan the QR code to the right and create your online account.







### STEP 2. Begin your Admission Application

 When you are ready to start your transfer admission application, access the application through your online admissions portal.

### **Transfer Admission Deadlines:**

Fall 2025 Entry: Admission Application Deadline is August 12, 2025

Spring 2026 Entry (Mid-Year Transfer): Admission Application Deadline is December 6, 2025

Fall 2026 Entry: Admission Application Deadline is August 11, 2026



### STEP 3. Submit your Recommendations to ND

- We require two recommendations one recommendation should be from your Guidance Counselor or Principal and the other recommendation should be from your current grade Math or English Teacher.
- Request your recommendations in your admissions portal.



### STEP 4. Request your Report Cards, Transcripts, and Standardized Test Scores

- Please send transcripts/report cards from the past two years, and the current year grades as soon as they are available. We will review applications with the first quarter or first trimester grades of the current year.
- Please request any Connecticut Mastery Tests, PSAT or any other standardized testing to be sent to ND.
- Records can be requested through your online admissions portal or by submitting a records release form to
  your current high school records office to authorize the release of your transcripts and standardized
  test scores.



### STEP 5. Schedule your Family Admissions Interview

The final step to complete the transfer admission process is a family admission interview. The interview is an
opportunity for us to answer questions you might have, review your application, discuss course placement, and
finalize your admission decision, standardized test results along with the other components of your application
will provide a full picture of your academic abilities and potential. Please remember that your standardized test
scores are only one part of your total application.


